Senior MP advisor on security & policing

- ND, COS, COs (CANELEMNORAD)
- Dir Command Security (N&NC)
- Liaison with local forces
 - Security Forces Squadrons (MP)
 - Civilian police (CSPD, etc.)
- Facilitate (N&NC ↔ Canada)
 - Foreign disclosure
 - Visits (DV, TD)



Incident/Accident/Discipline

- Inform Chain of Command ASAP (family included!)
 - Know who to call in case of an emergency
- SOFA (Status of Forces Agreement)
 - Applies to CAF/DND/dependents
- Off-limit areas
 - Listed in RO
 - Strong recommendations to civilians/dependents

Gun Ownership Statistics Colorado



Gun ownership in Colorado has declined by 3% since 2013. However, the number of firearms purchased has increased.



There are at least 7,758,000 million firearms in Colorado.



In Colorado, there are 1.2 firearms per resident.



Household gun ownership in Colorado decreased from 50% to 45% from 1990 to 2023.



7% of Coloradans report carrying a firearm daily.



The average Colorado gun owner has between 4 and 5 firearms.



72% of the state's 1,004 firearm-related deaths in 2023 were suicides.



Travel restrictions and prohibitions

- Canada.ca (Travel and Tourism)
- Travel.state.gov

Use GREEN passport

- Cruises and return travel get passport checked and stamped upon return to U.S
- If not, severe issues may occur exiting/returning



NOIT

- Duty travel outside Canada & U.S.
 - Required
- Non-duty travel (Personal)
 - Encouraged
- How to submit
 - Monitor Mass
 - Web form (DGDS site)
- Green badge holder
 - N&NC SSO briefing for travel outside Canada/U.S.



Access & ID

CAC / Dependant Cards

- Attend Visitor Centres to activate privileges
- Re-verified every six months
- Return cards when posted out (CAC, Bldg.)

NDI 20

- Pull them out and check expiry date
- Contact me for renewal
- VCRs
- Security Clearances



Security

- Security is taken seriously and there are differences between Cdn and U.S. rules
- Communicate with your USS (Cdn) and SM (U.S.)
- N&NC 101 Trg
 - Mandatory for NORAD & USNORTHCOM personnel
 - Booked by SM/supervisor
- Pay attention to security marking on documents
 - NOFORN
 - FVEY
 - CEO
- N&NC has a 100% shred policy



Frequent Infractions

- Tokens left in reader (CAC/SIPR/PKI)
- Computers not screen-locked
- Cabinets & safes left open
- Improper destruction of classified material
- PED in bldgs. (Smart watches, Wi-Fi, BT)
