CURLING INTERSECTION LEAGUE

BY-LAWS

The following will constitute the By-Laws governing 8 Wing/CFB Trenton's Intersection Curling League. The Military Sports Office and the league committee members will review these by-laws annually before the start of the season.

The current 8 Wing/CFB Trenton Intersection Sports Constitution shall dictate the policies and procedures upon how the league will operate. A copy of this Constitution shall be issued to the league committee members.

TEAM REGISTRATION:

1. The league must have a minimum of four (4) teams registered in order for the season to commence. Units/Teams shall submit a nominal roll comprising of a minimum of ten (10) players in order to enter a team into the league. Should a unit fail to meet the required nominal role, they may combine with a subsequent unit who also are short players.
2. Rosters are to include any players who could potentially join the team later in the season but are unavailable at the beginning due to tasks and operations. Any new players posted to 8 Wing/CFB Trenton during the season who are not yet on a team roster can join their affiliated Unit team, provided the Military Sports office is notified.
3. Interested players belonging to a Unit that does not have a team in the league will go in the draft. Should players wish to play on a team other than their own Section or workgroup, the losing unit team rep must submit in writing to the Mil Sports Coord releasing the player. The player will go in the draft and assigned the team with the smallest roster. Failure to comply will result in the suspension of the released/waived player from further League play.
4. A player shall not be permitted to play / or be on the list of two (2) teams at the same time.

PLAYING RULES:

5. The 8 Wing/CFB Trenton Intersection Curling League will follow the rules of the Ontario Curling Association (OCA) using the free guard zone rule.
6. Team Reps are responsible to ensure that their team is on time for each draw.
7. In order for the game to commence, a team must have a minimum of three (3) players present.

8. If a team is late up to 10 minutes, one point will be awarded to the opposing team. The opposing team will retain last rock. Game will start at first end.
9. If a team is 11-20 minutes late, two points will be awarded to the opposing team. The opposing team will retain last rock. Game will start at third end.
10. If a team is late more than 20 minutes, the game will be forfeited. Forfeited games will be declared when:
 - either one or both teams do not show;
 - if after 20 minutes a team does not have a minimum 3 players;
 - if a team cancels after 1000hrs on the scheduled game day;
 - in-eligible players are used in the game.
11. Scores are to be reported, NLT 24 hours following game completion, by both reps, via email, to the Sports Coordinator.
12. Point system will be as follows:
 - 3 points per win
 - 2 points per tie
 - 1 point per loss
 - 0 points per No Show
13. Only clean indoor shoes or curling shoes are permitted on the ice surface. All indoor shoes/curling shoes must be hand carried into the club. There is no outdoor footwear allowed on the ice surface. Violators will be asked to leave. This rule will be monitored and enforced by staff at the Trenton Curling Club.
14. Mixing of Curling and Military attire is not allowed.

GAME LENGTH:

15. All games will consist of six (6) ends. If the sixth end hasn't started prior to 10 minutes before the end of the allocated booking- the game will be complete based on the score after five ends.
16. In the playoffs, the tie breaking procedure is as follows: one player's rock with sweeping. No sweeping from opposition.

SPARES:

17. Spares (5th player) may be substituted into a game at any point after an end has completed; unless due to injury.

DEFAULTED GAMES:

18. Team representatives must provide a minimum of 24 hours notice for all League game cancellations to the Mil Sports, League President, Vice President, and

opposing team reps. Any cancellations submitted with less than 24 hours notice will be considered a forfeit with the exception of Wing Recalls, Op Evals and any other Wing Operational requirements.

FORFEITS/NO SHOWS:

19. Games lost by forfeit (not enough players / in-eligible players) or no show will not be re-played. 8 Wing/CFB Trenton No Show Policy will apply.

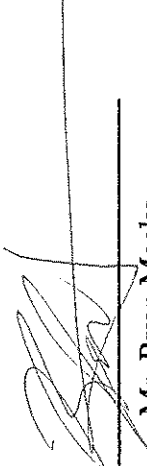
